



COVID-19 or “Coronavirus”

Due to the high concern of Covid-19 or Coronavirus and in an effort to lower the risk of spreading infection, especially for our elderly patients, we ask that if you are having any current respiratory illness, are currently running a fever or have recently traveled, that you postpone your eye appointment for 2 months. If you are having any possible conjunctivitis or “pink eye” symptoms you will be asked to text a picture of your eye(s) to send to the office to be shown to your physician.

We are still seeing patients for regular follow up and routine appointments at this time but are taking precautions by spreading appointments to minimize your time in the office and keep social distancing. This means that you may be required to see one of the other physicians in the office. We will still see emergency patients as needed but we ask that you be patient as we must ask questions regarding your recent travel, symptoms and any other pertinent information and relay this to your physician before scheduling an appointment.

Kirby Eye Center is doing our very best to decrease transmission of any infections by increasing the frequency of our existing sterilization procedures. We use sterilization sprays/wipes to clean all hard surface high traffic areas such as countertops, tabletops, keyboards, phones, door handles/knobs, chairs, etc., multiple times per day. We clean exam rooms (countertops, door handles, chairs) and equipment in between each patient.
